### **Junior League of Lynchburg Breaks Ground on Sprayground**

(LYNCHBURG, Va. – June 23, 2009) – At a groundbreaking event at Riverside Park, The Junior League of Lynchburg (JLL) presented a \$125,000 check to the City of Lynchburg for a zero-depth sprayground. The JLL is proud to provide this water feature as part of the Department of Parks and Recreation’s master plan for renovating Riverside Park. It will be free to the community and the first of its kind in Central Virginia.

“We are very excited to provide a new opportunity for children and parents to spend time together,” said Tracey Dixon, JLL president.

The sprayground reflects JLL’s commitment to Smart Moves, a community-wide effort to encourage children to maintain active and healthy lifestyles. The idea behind this interactive splash area is to encourage families and kids of all ages and abilities to spend time playing outdoors while also enjoying the beauty of Riverside Park.

The sprayground is the result of three years of successful planning and fundraising by the JLL, in cooperation with the City of Lynchburg.
