The Junior League of Lynchburg is a group of women volunteers working to make Central Virginia a better place. The JLL is open to any woman over the age of 21 who resides in the greater Lynchburg area. Our membership welcomes women of all races, religions and national origins. Our membership includes women who want to make a stronger impact in our community. We are single women, married women, moms, business women, and any combination of these groups.

### **Membership Dues:**

Provisional Members \$100/year

**Provisional Dues go towards the following: \$50 AJLI, \$25 application fee to cover materials costs for the year, \$25 towards provisional class project.** After your provisional year your dues increase by \$10 and become \$110 year. (Dues may be paid in payments or all at once. \$50 of your dues payment is due by Aug. 31, 2017)
