AJLI:

Comprised of 292 Junior Leagues in the United States, Canada, Mexico, and Great Britain, the Association of Junior Leagues International Inc. (AJLI) has been providing support, guidance and leadership development opportunities to member Leagues for more than 80 years. More than 190,000 Junior League members have been the driving force behind the kinds of initiatives and institutions that make communities healthier, including: childhood immunization, family literacy, women's shelters, children's museums, historic preservation, leadership development, and more.

AJLI strives to unite all the Junior Leagues; provide continuity and support; and serve as a steward for the Junior League Movement. Today, through regional, national, and international meetings, comprehensive resources and customized consultations, AJLI adds value to our member Leagues in their fulfillment of the Junior League mission.

Can You Imagine Lynchburg Without...? (The following were all JLL initiatives)

- **Amazement Square**—Central Virginia's first multidisciplinary, hands-on children's museum
- **The Free Clinic of Central Virginia**—providing access to basic healthcare services to those with limited resources
- **Central Virginia CASA and Kids' Haven**—advocacy and support programs for children
- **Smart Moves**—a community-wide coalition to fight childhood obesity and family wellness
- **The Adult Daycare Center**—providing health, social and support service for adults
- **Riverside Park Sprayground**—a community project that provides children a free, safe, handicap accessible place to play

Provisional Year Meetings and Participation:

Active members attend a general membership meeting once a month and a committee meeting once a month. During your provisional year you will attend a monthly provisional member session in addition to the general membership meeting. The 2019-2020 list of dates, events and membership requirements will be given out at the Super Saturday meeting in August. Below are some examples of what to expect.

Sample Provisional Course Requirements

- Attend JLL August Super Saturday Session
- Attend General Membership Meetings
- Complete 4 Community Project Requirements (CPRs)
- JLL 101
- Participation in JLL's Little Black Dress Initiative
- Attend 1 Board of Directors meeting
- Participate in 1 Done-In-A-Day with a JLL Community Partner
- Secure an Annual Campaign donation of \$100 or more
- Participate in the Provisional Project
- Volunteer at 1 JLL signature event
- Sell \$100 worth of tickets to JLL's *All Aboard!* event

Membership Dues:

Provisional Members \$100/year

Provisional Dues go towards the following: \$50 AJLI, \$25 application fee to cover materials costs for the year, \$25 towards provisional class project. After your provisional year your dues increase by \$10 and become \$110 year. (Dues may be paid in payments or all at once, via check or PayPal. \$50 of your dues payment is due by August 31st, 2019)
